

HALF ARABIAN JERSEYBRED RULES

1. Horses must be New Jersey bred, and must have a "New Jersey Bred Permanent Certification – Non Racing Breeds" certificate, issued at no fee, (see attached OWNER'S ELIGIBILITY DECLARATION FOR NEW JERSEY BRED HORSES), in order to show at the NJ Bred All Breed Show and participate in the Jerseybred Year End Awards Program.
2. To be eligible for the Jerseybred Year End Awards, a \$15 per category nomination fee must be paid.
3. Horses must be nominated annually. Nominations should be sent by e-mail (conformation of receipt will be sent) or by U.S. MAIL (include a S.A.S.E. if you would like a conformation of receipt). Do **NOT** send CERTIFIED. NO TELEPHONE entries will be accepted.
4. At least one owner must be a member of **NJHAHA**, in good standing (dues paid) at the time of nomination. The owner, lessee or purchaser (with an installment plan) that is making the nomination must adhere to the membership requirement. (Lessee and/or purchaser-on-installment must furnish copies of contracts). In the case of a horse being sold after being nominated, the horse's nomination **MUST** be transferred to the new owner and a \$5 fee per category must be paid by the new owner to keep them in the program. Year end prize money will be paid to the individual recorded as the owner on the nomination form.
5. Horse must be recorded under exact name and number as registered with the Arabian Horse Association Half Arabian Registry.
6. **NO POINTS WILL BE COUNTED UNTIL THE HORSE IS NOMINATED.** Points won before the horse is nominated or after the closing date of November 1 will not count toward the year-end awards.
7. **DEADLINE FOR POINT RETURNS: NOVEMBER 1.** Points will **not** be considered if **postmarked/emailed/faxed after November 1.** Points must be tabulated by the owner, on the correct form. **Illegible or incorrect** Point Return Forms will be returned to the owner, and must be resubmitted correctly by the November 1 deadline. Point returns should be sent by e-mail (conformation of receipt will be sent), by fax, or by U.S. MAIL (include a S.A.S.E. if you would like a conformation of receipt). Do **NOT** send CERTIFIED. Please include a copy of AHA On-Line Competition Report verifying placings for all shows (except the NJ Bred All Breed Show and the NJB # 2 Show - the results for those two shows are on record with the Jerseybred Point Chairperson) Please contact chairperson if you don't have access to the internet.
8. **A HORSE MUST BE ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED IN THE NJ BRED ALL BREED HORSE SHOW IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR JERSEYBRED YEAR END AWARDS.**
9. **A HORSE MUST BE ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED IN AT LEAST THREE (3) DIFFERENT NEW JERSEY SHOWS IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR JERSEYBRED YEAR END AWARDS (PER CATEGORY ENTERED).**
10. You should report the points from your 3 best shows. Must be under 3 different judges. An additional show(s) should be reported for tie breaking purposes (Tie-Breakers need not be under a different judge). **You MUST list 3 shows**, whether the horse placed or not. Points may be used from any USEF rated Half-Arabian Division, The New Jersey Bred All Breed Show, or the NJB #2 Show. You may use out-of-state shows, provided you have also shown in three (3) New Jersey shows, **including the NJ Bred All Breed Show.** Any falsification will be grounds for disqualification, with all winnings forfeited.
11. The NJ Bred All Breed Show uses a two-judge judging method. The designated Jerseybred judge will determine the placings for The NJ Bred All Breed Show and will earn **"A" rated, Championship points** for the first six placings, **plus 10 extra points for each CLASS shown.** The second judge will determine the placings for the NJB #2 Show; this is a **separate** show, and will earn regular "A" rated points (not championship points & no bonus points). **DO NOT COMBINE THESE TWO SHOWS.**
12. In order to earn points in a class, there must be at least **TWO (2)** horses entered, shown and judged in that class.
13. You may **NOT** use Show/Grand Champion or Reserve, in halter classes, unless the show does not offer Junior/Senior Championships.
14. Working Hunter Section Champion receives 10 bonus points, Reserve receives 5 bonus points. Dressage Level Champion receives 10 bonus points, Reserve receives 5 bonus points. They do **NOT** count as classes.
15. If using points from Regional, East Coast, or National Shows (U.S., Sport Horse, Canadian, Youth), you may not combine your Championship or Reserve with your Top5/Top10 (i.e. there is a Champion, a Reserve, and 3 other Top 5's)
16. A Regional Show/East Coast Show is a separate show in itself, and can **NOT** be combined with a pre-show (i.e. – Eastern Arabian and the East Coast Championships are two different shows and can not be combined).
17. Points will not be accepted from any show that does not require a current negative Coggins test.
18. If any of the conditions set down by the committee are not met, all prizes may be forfeited without remuneration of any and all fees.
19. Any disputes over points or placings will be adjudicated by the committee and all decisions made by the committee will be final.
